

FBC Kennedy Scholarship Requirements
First timers and Repeat Applicants

1. Must be a member of FBC who has actively participated in church programs.
2. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA or have a 3.0 GPA graduating from high school.
3. Must be accepted into an accredited college/university or other institute of higher learning and must be enrolled in a degree granting program.
4. Must be a full-time student.
5. Applicant must be HOPE Scholarship eligible except for the GA residency requirement.
6. Application must be completed and submitted to the committee by **June 15, 2020**, including reference form, schedule, essay, and official transcript. To be considered an official transcript it must be in the original, sealed envelope or an e-transcript must be emailed from the school to KRose@fbcaugusta.org.

It is the student's responsibility to have the transcript submitted to the Scholarship Committee by the deadline. If the transcript is not in the student's folder when the committee meets they will not grant a scholarship.

15. Have one letter of recommendation sent directly to the Scholarship Committee of First Baptist Church. Use the Personal Reference Form prepared by the Scholarship Committee. This form must be submitted by a member of first Baptist Church of Augusta. It is the student's responsibility to have the letter submitted to the Scholarship Committee by the deadline. If the letter is not in the student's folder when the committee meets, they will not grant a scholarship.

16. All applicants must submit an essay of 2-3 pages. Select one of the topics listed below. The essay must be an original copy, type written, and double spaced.

- Tell about a recent experience when you were the "salt of the earth" and how did that impact you both short term and long term?
- If all believers are called to be ministers/servants of Christ, how do you see yourself using your education/degree as a minister/servant of Christ?
- Option for first time applicants only: Describe a significant experience that has been instrumental in your development as a Christian.

If awarded a Kennedy Scholarship, I understand that:

- Checks will be made to the institution of higher learning and not to the individual. You will need to provide an address for the appropriate office.
- You will need to maintain a 3.0 GPA and provide the church proof of grades at the end Fall Semester.
- You will need to re-apply each year for the scholarship and meet eligibility requirements.
- You must maintain full-time status and provide a copy of the Spring semester schedule.
- You must visit three different worship services during the Fall semester and write a one-page reflection paper about each experience—how you were impacted by the worship experience--and submit to the committee no later than November 30.
