

Week Four: February 19 -24
Pray for Good Actions

Monday

Think of a way God has acted in your life recently and thank Him for it.

Tuesday

Pray for someone you can actively bless today.

Wednesday

Pray that you would be mindful of ways you might be the presence of Christ to other people.

Thursday

Ask God to show you the work He has for you specifically in the body of First Baptist Augusta.

Friday

Pray that God will show you if there are any ways you might work more effectively for Him.

Saturday

Thank God for the blessings of this focused time of prayer and ask God to do a mighty work in our church.

Pray for the People of First Baptist Augusta

Monday

Identify at least three people who have been part of the body of Christ for you and thank God for them.

Tuesday

Identify someone in our church who has helped move the mission of our church forward and thank God for them.

Wednesday

Pray for the administrative and ministerial staff of our church, as they show Christ's love for others.

Thursday

Pray for the lay leaders of our church and ask God to lead and direct them.

Friday

Pray for uniting love in our church body that we may work effectively for the glory of God.

Saturday

Pray that God will provide ways for you to actively participate in our church body.

Week Two: February 5 – 10
Thank God for What He Has Given Us

Monday

Thank God for the material blessings you have received. Make a mental note of at least five.

Tuesday

Thank God for the material blessings He has provided to our congregation over the last 200+ years.

Wednesday

Thank God for the material blessings He has allowed us to provide to our community through the years.

Thursday

Remember a specific need that God has met in your life and offer thanks for that.

Friday

Thank God for the spiritual blessings that He has provided to our church and its members.

Saturday

Thank God for the ministry of our church as we strive to connect others with Jesus and our community of faith.

Week Three: February 12 – 17
Ask God for Wisdom

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives to all generously without reproach, and it will be given him.
James 1:5

Monday

Pray for wisdom to carry out God's purpose for our lives and for our church.

Tuesday

Pray for wisdom for those planning and implementing the capital campaign.

Wednesday

Pray for wisdom for each member of the body to know what their stewardship role should be.

Thursday

Pray for wisdom to know what we need to do in our own lives to reflect God's plan for our resources.

Friday

Pray for wisdom in your individual giving.

Saturday

Pray for wisdom in determining how to move our church's mission forward.
